Sharon holds bachelor and master degrees in advertising from Flagler College and is the owner of "Wicked Branding and Graphix".

This was her second visit to the Club. 18 months ago she and Jim Mitzel from Hampton spoke about the Fallen Heroes program, which is partnering with Jim's organization, Hampton Veterans Memorial Fund, Inc. to erect monuments to fallen warriors. These monuments are placed at high schools attended by the deceased service person. Having successfully completed the fund raising for Bradford High School, they are now raising funds to erect a monument at Keystone Heights High School.

The cost of each monument is \$7,000. So far, \$1700 has been raised for Keystone's monument. The monument will honor all fallen heroes who attended Keystone High School, including Sgt. Richard Lee and Gary Cooper. Sgt. Lee and his canine fellow-soldier were killed in action most recently. An anonymous Kiwanian donated \$500 on the spot for a special addition to the monument for the dog.

One of the ways funds are raised are special events. The Hampton Veterans Memorial Fund will have its 2018 Chili Cookoff on October 13 at the "Howlin Wolf" in Putnam Hall. There will be trophies for the best chili. Club member Smitty Huffman plans on entering and guarantees he will place no lower than second. If he doesn't meet his goal, he will donate \$20 to the Club. The cookoff will feature several live bands, including "Bubba Can't Dance" from Keystone.
