**Peyton is the Clay County Community Resource Development Agent for the University of Florida Extension Service. She recently moved to Keystone Heights. A Louisiana native, she received her undergraduate degree from L.S.U. Her graduate work was done at the University of Florida.**

**She explained that each state has an extension service at a “land grant” university; Florida’s is at U of F. The Extension service is a free resource to Floridians.**

**Started as primarily an agricultural service provider to give a “practical education” to the public, it has expanded to include several consumer services. Her specialty (one of only four such specialist in Florida) is community development. Other specialties provided through her office in Green Cove Springs include business development, horticulture, and, of course, agriculture. There is a professional bee keeper on staff and two 4-H agents.**

**Peyton has been focusing on teen and young adult career development by providing**

**information on resume' writing, appropriate wardrobe, deportment, and job mock interviewing. She will be bringing her program to Keystone's library in the near future and is looking for volunteers to help with the mock interviews.**
